"AS BEING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE BODY OF CHRIST..."

Definition of regeneration:

 Regeneration is the sovereign work of God – through the Holy Spirit who grants spiritual to each Christian, raising them from the dead so that they are now able to repent and trust in Christ as a new creation. [Ezekiel 36:22-32; Ezekiel 36:27; John 3:1-5; Acts 16:14; 2 Corinthians 4:1-6; Ephesians 2:1-5, Philippians 1:29; James 1:8; 1 Peter 1:3; 1 John 5:1]

What is Worship?

Definition of Worship:

• Worshipping God is an act made possible only by God. We are engaging with God as His regenerate creation [on his terms] by giving glory to Him, honoring Him and focusing all of our attention toward Him.

How First Baptist Gathers

TEN CORE PRINCIPLES OF WORSHIP:

- 1. GOD'S GLORY ABOVE ALL: Christian worship should be aimed at bringing glory and honor to God alone, with a focus on His greatness, holiness, and majesty.
- 2. SCRIPTURE-BASED: Christian worship should be grounded in and shaped by the truths and principles found in Scripture. Nothing said or sung should be in contradiction to Scripture.
- 3. GOSPEL-CENTERED: Christian worship should center on the gospel of Jesus Christ, highlighting His life, death, resurrection, and the salvation He offers to humanity through faith in Him.
- 4. **SPIRIT-LED:** Christian worship should be guided by the Holy Spirit, with a sensitivity to His leading and an openness to His presence and work among the worshipers.
- 5. **CONGREGATIONAL PARTICIPATION:** Christian worship should encourage and facilitate the active participation of the congregation, involving them in singing, praying, and responding to God's Word as a unified body of believers.
- 6. CHRIST-EXALTING: Christian worship should prioritize songs and music that exalt Jesus Christ, His character, and His redemptive work, helping worshipers to magnify and adore Him.
- 7. **HUMILITY AND REVERENCE:** Christian worship should be characterized by a humble and reverent attitude, recognizing the awe-inspiring holiness of God and our unworthiness to approach Him apart from His grace.
- 8. **OFFERING OUR BEST TO GOD:** Christian worship should strive for excellence in all aspects, including musicality, creativity, and sound production, as an offering of our best to God.
- 9. **DIVERSE AND INCLUSIVE:** Christian worship should be inclusive and embrace the diversity of God's people, welcoming people of different ages, cultures, and backgrounds, and creating an environment where all can worship together.
- 10. **DISCIPLESHIP AND TRANSFORMATION:** Christian worship should be part of the discipleship process, aiming to transform hearts and minds, deepen faith, and foster spiritual growth among worshipers, leading them to live out their faith in their daily lives.

FOCUS ON SCRIPTURE

To make sure that God remains the focus – your elders have determined to utilize Scripture through every part of our time of worship:

- Read the Bible [1 Timothy 4:13; Colossians 4:15-16]
 - Call to Worship
- Preach the Bible [Acts 2:42; 1 Timothy 4:13]
 - Expository Preaching
- Pray_the Bible [Acts 2:42; 1 Timothy 6:12]
 - Throughout the Service
- <u>Sing</u> the Bible [The Psalms; Ephesians 5:19]
 - To deepen our relationship with God
- And, <u>See</u> the Bible: Meaning Scripture being "seen" through giving [Mark 12:41-44] & ordinances of the Lord's Supper and Baptism by Immersion. [Acts 2:42; 1 Corinthians 11]

Worship God through Preaching: Expository Preaching [Nehemiah 8:8; Isaiah 55:10-11; Acts 2:14-41, 12:24, 13:16-47; 2 Timothy 4:2-5]

Expository preaching means that Pastor Jacob ______ a passage of Scripture [Book of Acts for example], and ______ that passage of Scripture. He then ______ it around a central theme and main divisions which are taken from the text itself, and then he ______ it to our lives.

The goal is not just to impart information but to transform lives through the power of God's Word. The best way for you to get the most out of the sermon is to study the passage that will be preached on before you come on Sunday morning. Every week, we publish the next week's passage in the weekly bulletin.

Worship God through Music

- Music was given to us to deepen our relationship with God.
- 3 reasons we utilize music to worship God
 - To <u>reflect</u> the picture of God's Glory [Zephaniah 3:17; Hebrews 2:22; Ephesians 5:18-21]
 - That we might respond fully to Him [The Psalms]
 - And, to remember and meditate on His Word [Colossians 3:16]

Worship God through our Giving
