OUR MISSION

Our mission is simple, **First Baptist Portland exists to glorify God by making disciples of Jesus Christ in our church, community, and throughout the world.**

OUR CORE VALUES

Our purpose is shaped through these six non-negotiable core values.

- **God:** We believe in one God who exists eternally as three distinct persons, but in one essence: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit, each of whom is fully God, yet there is one God.
- God as Creator & Sovereign: We believe God has made Himself known to the world in Jesus Christ, the infallible Scriptures, and His Creation. We believe that God created the world from nothing and is over all things, at all times and in all places.
- Humans as part of God's Creation & our Sinful Condition: We believe that all humanity is created in the image of God and possesses intrinsic dignity and worth.

- **Continued:** We believe that we have inherited our sin from Adam & Eve. We believe our sin has separated us from God which leaves all of humanity in desperate need of salvation.
- Jesus Christ & His work of Salvation: We believe that Jesus Christ is the One and only Son of God. We believe He came to Earth in human form to live a perfect life to redeem God's Creation. We believe that He was arrested, crucified, died, set in a tomb, and conquered death on the third day. We believe that salvation is through Jesus Christ by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone. We believe that Jesus Christ is returning to the world in the future to judge the living and the dead.
- **The Role & Mission of the Church:** We believe that the Church is the body of Christ which has been sent into the world to be the light of and share the Gospel of Jesus Christ for the glory of God.
- **The Authority & Inerrancy of Scripture:** We believe in the authority and inerrancy of Scripture. This means that all things that the Scriptures assert are wholly true, both in the Old Testament, the Scriptures of Jesus and the apostles, and in the New Testament, the writings of the apostles. This inerrancy means that all things that the Scriptures assert function with the authority of God's own Word for Christians.
